JOHN R. CASH

Born in 1932 in Kingsland, Arkansas, and raised on a cotton farm, J.R. Cash released his first hit record in 1955 (“Hey Porter”) and won an MTV Video Music Award in 2003 (“Hurt”) just 15 days before his death. Johnny Cash distinguished himself as one of the giant figures in American music. He wrote and recorded rock-and-roll, blues, rockabilly, country folk and gospel and was the only living artist to be inducted into all three major music halls of fame.

Director and co-lyricist of Andrew Lloyd Webber's *Song & Dance*, 1986 (Tony Award for star Bernadette Peters). With composer David Shire: director/lyricist *Baby*, 1983 (book by Sybille Pearson; seven Tony Award nominations); Lyricist: *Big*, 1996 (book by John Weidman. Tony nomination: Best Score). Off-Broadway credits: director/lyricist *Starting Here, Starting Now*, 1977 (Grammy Award nomination); *Closer Than Ever*, 1989 (Outer Critics Circle Awards: Best Musical, Best Score). Contributes devilish crossword puzzles to Harpers Magazine. Son of well-known orchestra leader; married to Janet Brenner; five children: Nicholas, David, Jordan, Emily and Charlotte.

Bill Meade began his career as a musician. He has been a featured soloist with numerous orchestras, including the Zurich Philharmonic, Prague Philharmonic, and Jacksonville Symphony. He has produced concerts throughout the U.S. and Europe with artists ranging from Arlo Guthrie to BB King. Television: "The Miss America Pageant," "The Super Bowl Half Time Show," "Sex and The City," "Love Monkey," and "Sesame Street." On Broadway, he has been involved with more than 50 musicals. He is a Grammy-nominated record producer with a wide range of theatrical releases to his credit, from *Hello, Dolly!* With Carol Channing to *Elegies* by William Finn.

Trina Williamson Jackson (*Director, Keyboard, Singer*) Trina is celebrating 43 years of working at BCT! She recently directed *The Sound of Music* at Kitsap Forest Theater and *Mary Poppins* here at BCT. Next on her plate is directing *Cinderella* at Kitsap Forest Theater!
